
IBCP with a Pathway in Business

Pre-university programmes for students from 16 to 18.

The IBCP with a Pathway in Business at BCG is the perfect opportunity for those students who are considering Business as their top career choice while continuing with the discipline, rigour and international mindedness of the IB.

Students will acquire the knowledge and skills they need to embark on a business-related career while developing lifelong skills in applied knowledge, critical thinking, communication, and cross-cultural engagement. Students take three IB subject courses, complete the IBCP core and study seven modules with the EU Business School, both online and at their campus in Barcelona.

This pathway will allow students to explore, understand and engage in real world business applications that will be of great use to them in the future as professionals but it will also provide them with the academic knowledge needed for their bachelor's degree.



Upon successful completion, students are automatically admitted into the first year of EU Business School Bachelor's Programmes at any of their campuses in Barcelona, Munich or Geneva.

For students that want to participate in practical work placements at local companies to give an insight into a 'real-life' working environment and independent learners with a more practical mindset interested in a more hands-on approach.
